My 5* Star Walk

This walk takes around an hour - a little longer if there's lots to sniff!!

- Setting off from the Crown Inn, walk up Star Lane, (this is me looking over the 1st stile to check that there are no cows in the field)
- Just past the farm track, we're just about to enter my favourite field, with lots of voles to sniff out in the tufts of grass. I'm also fascinated by the raised 'road' that crosses this field from left to right - I wonder how old this is? (This is a view across the field at sundown)
- Jump the stile and I'm in field 2, with Roundabout Lane in my sights at the far side
- Turn right here, not forgetting to check for crab apples on the right.
- At the end, we turn left and walk along the verge - always a good chance of a bunny or two along here.
- Then it's left along the track (pictured at speed on the right) until we get to 'owl wood' (pictured) - at least that's what I call it. We've also seen a weasel here - but it was much too fast for me (and the guy with the camera!)
- Along here and when we turn left over the stile into field 3. There's lots of sloes here - not that I get to taste any of the Sloe Gin my master makes after making me wait hours while he picks them (see pic)
- The hedge on the right has been full of finches, playing tag with us as we cross the field.
- At the end, over the stile into roundabout Lane again, with the 'Roundabout' of trees to our right.
- At the end of this, we're on the 'home stretch' (Mays Lane), with just a short dash up the footpath that crosses the field back to Star Lane. (this pic of the bunker was taken from here).
