#### **Avening Church**

The Church building remains open but no public services at present. Please do visit, but you will need to adhere to the current health procedures. #### **Foodbank Arrangements**

The box remains in church for donations to Tetbury foodbank. Items particularly needed are: tinned soup, long-life milk, tinned vegetables, biscuits, instant mash/tinned potatoes, rice pudding, long-life sponge pudding, long-life juice, tinned fruit, tinned tomatoes, teabags. The Tetbury centre is currently only open on Tuesday mornings.

#### **Avening Primary School**

The school is closed to most pupils. However it is providing childcare for children of key health workers and certain other pupils, and continues to provide school meals for qualifying pupils. They are being supported by the **Friends of Avening School**.

#### Avening Community Café

Is running a roadside library at 6 Old Hill (10-2pm daily), a plant and produce swap outside 14 High Street and is regularly updating its Facebook page with quizzes, recipes and news.
